**ORDER FOR
SUPERVISED PARENTING TIME**

WHEREAS, the Court finds it appropriate and in the best interests of the minor child(ren) to have parenting time with the non-residential parent, and the Court finds that said parenting time should be supervised and monitored, until further order of the Court;

IT IS ORDERED that said parenting time shall take place at the family parenting time center known as "Erma's House" located at 1046 Brown Street, Dayton, Ohio 45409 (Phone # 586-9586). The parties/parents shall contact Erma's House within ten (10) days, to complete the intake and assessment process. The residential parent shall make the child(ren) available promptly for all scheduled parenting time sessions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the non-residential parent/visiting parent shall cooperate with the staff of Erma's House and abide by all rules, conditions and requirements established by Erma's House. WARNING: Failure to do so shall cause this order for supervised parenting time to be suspended immediately, and no further parenting time shall occur until further order of court after an evidentiary hearing is held upon the motion of the non-custodial parent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Erma's House shall mail to the Court: within thirty (30) days, (1) a written report as to whether the non-residential parent has contacted the center as ordered, whether the non-residential parent has completed the intake process as ordered, and whether supervised parenting time is appropriate based upon the assessment; AND on a quarterly basis, (2) a report as to whether the non-residential parent has abided by all rules, conditions and requirements of the center, as well as a monitoring report of any supervised visits. Copies of each report shall be mailed to each attorney and unrepresented party named below.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the written reports from Erma's House shall be accepted into evidence by the Court at any scheduled hearing as the direct examination of the author of each report, subject to cross-examination by either party. It is the responsibility of the party wishing to offer such cross-examination into evidence to subpoena the appropriate individual for any hearing.
