WHERE TO GO TO BE FINGERPRINTED

You have been given an order to get fingerprinted by the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department.

You **MUST** report to the general information and visitation desk in the Montgomery County Jail, located at 330 West Second Street. To get there from the Common Pleas Court Building:

1. Go out at the Perry Street entrance and turn left.
2. At Second Street, turn left again.
3. The Montgomery County Jail will be the first building you come to, and the entrance will be at the far end (West End).
4. Go into the lobby and turn right.
5. Straight ahead will be the general information and visitation desk.
6. Show the Corrections Officer at the desk your Fingerprint Order and they will have you go through the metal detector.
7. Be seated until the Fingerprint Officer comes to escort you inside.

NOTE: You may only have a wallet and car keys.
